SRI LANKAN CUSTOMS REGULATION ON DECLARATION AND IDENTIFICATIONS/ALLOWANCES

For identification under Sri Lanka Customs regulations for Unaccompanied Passenger Baggage (UPB), travellers must submit a UPB declaration form and proof of identity, such as a valid Sri Lankan passport. The declaration form is available on the Sri Lanka Customs website. Dual citizens with a Sri Lankan passport are eligible for UPB allowances.

Elaboration:

Declaration Form:

The UPB declaration form is a crucial document for identifying the passenger and the goods they are sending to Sri Lanka.

Proof of Identity:

A valid Sri Lankan passport is the primary form of identification required for claiming UPB allowances.

Dual Citizens:

Dual citizens who possess and use the Sri Lankan passport are eligible for UPB benefits.

Baggage Allowance:

Passengers are eligible for a baggage allowance for UPB if they have not fully utilized their baggage allowance upon arrival.

Purchased Goods:

If a passenger has purchased goods at Sri Lanka Duty Free Shops and fully utilized their baggage allowance upon arrival, they are not eligible for the UPB allowance.

Partial Utilization:

If a passenger has partially utilized their baggage allowance upon arrival, they are entitled to a proportionately calculated balance of the baggage allowance for UPB
